

# EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITY FIREFIGHTER/EMT (ENTRY LEVEL & LATERAL)



Make a positive difference as a Firefighter/EMT with the City of Bryan Fire Department.

Qualifying individuals will be subject to a testing process, background investigation, oral interviews and a medical examination.

The City of Bryan, Ohio is accepting applications for the position of Firefighter/EMT. The department currently has 2 open full-time positions for 24 hour shifts. The City of Bryan Fire Department serves a population of over 13,000 within the city and surrounding townships over a 72 square mile area with an annual call volume of just under 2,000 per year. Applicants must be at least 18 years of age and possess a valid driver's license.

**Entry level applicants** (those not currently employed full-time as a firefighter) must complete a written test through the National Testing Network (NTN). To complete the NTN application and schedule a test, go to [www.nationaltestingnetwork.com](http://www.nationaltestingnetwork.com), select Firefighter and sign up for Bryan Fire Department. Candidates who attain a passing score on the entry level exam will be invited to participate in the other stages of the selection process. National Testing Network does not replace the Bryan Fire Department's responsibility and decision making in the testing process. All candidate results are provided to the Bryan Fire Department where the final decisions are made.

Lateral applications (those currently employed with two (2) years full-time service as a firefighter) are not required to complete the written test. Lateral applicants are required to complete all other stages of the selection process.
