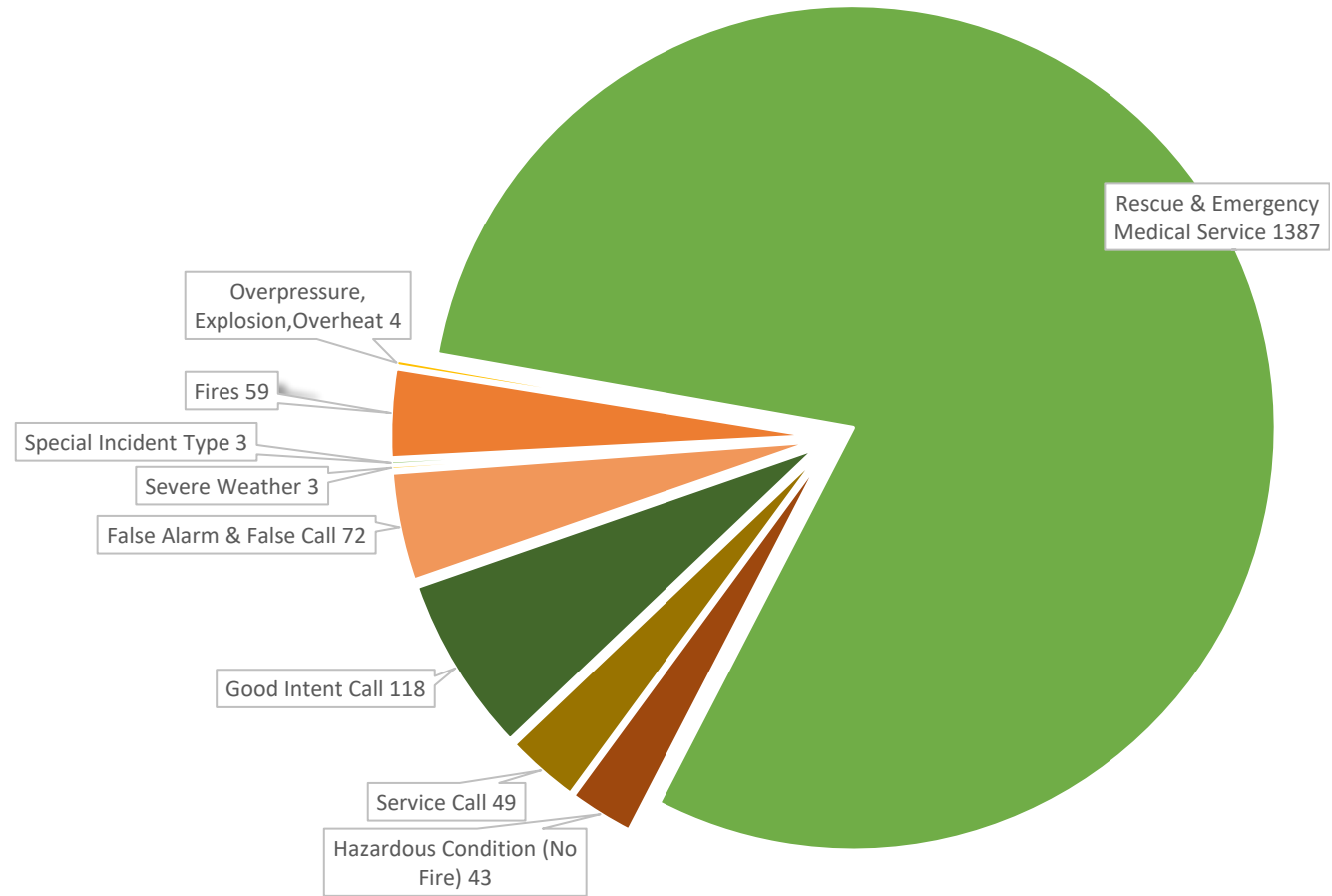

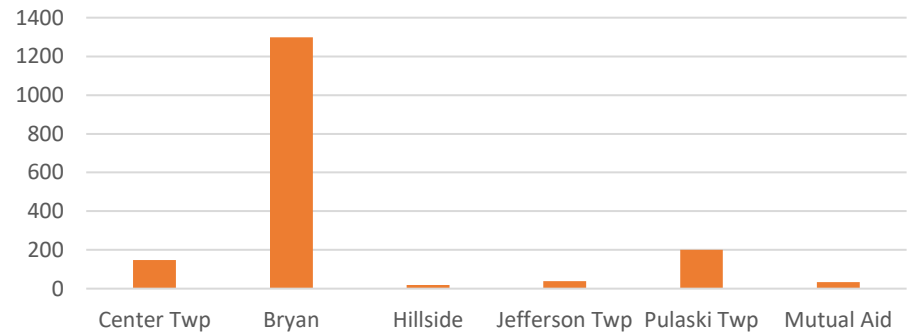

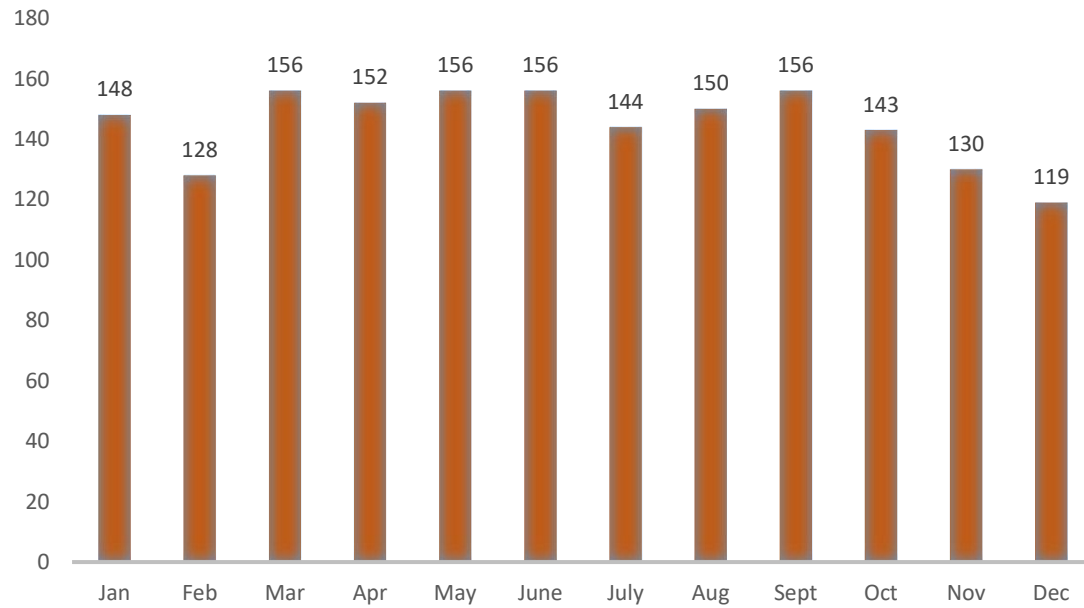

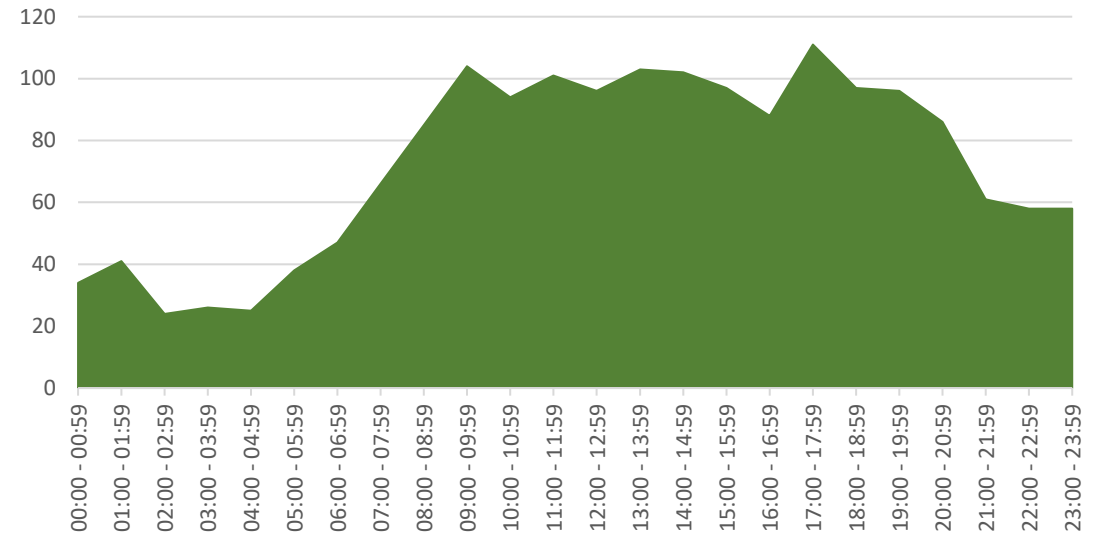

CALLS BY MONTH

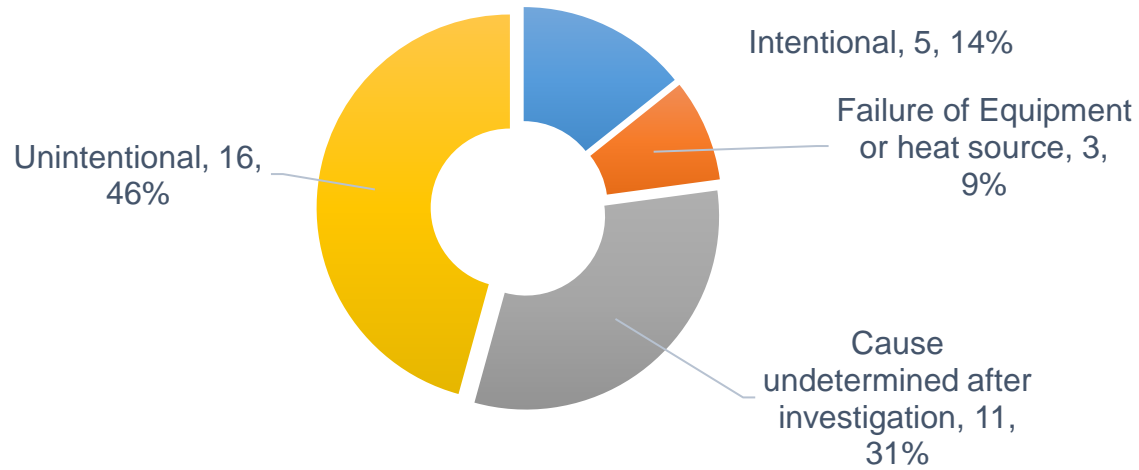


Incident by Hour of Day

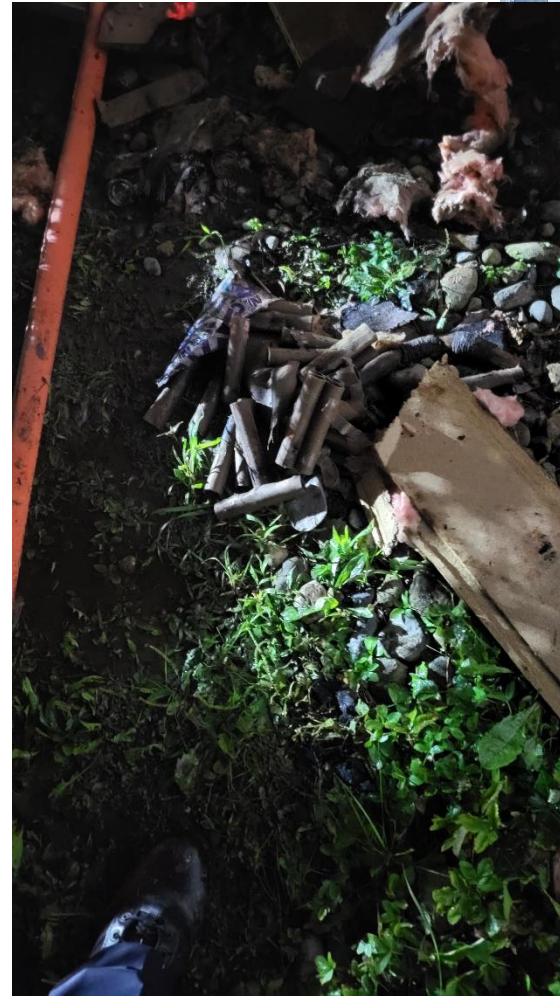
